## Important Information

**P**ractices can start after March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Your coach should be contacting you around that time to inform you of the practice schedule.

-We will pass out fundraiser information during the first week of practice. All money must be turned in on or before picture day (May 9<sup>th</sup>).

-Uniforms usually arrive the week of opening day.

-Games are played Mon-Sat. No games are played on Sundays, with the exception of tournaments. Most teams average two games a week.

-If you need to purchase any new equipment (gloves, cleats, bats, etc) we have discount coupons available to Dick's Sporting Goods. See your coach or a board member to get additional coupon sheets.

-You will need to supply a glove and cleats. A water bottle is also a good idea.



-It is usually still pretty cold during the first few weeks of the season. We recommend your child wears a long sleeve t-shirt (either white or black) under their jersey so as to not cover their number.

-No child may begin practice until we have a signed Release of Liability and a Medical Release Form on file.
